CAMP OBJECTIVES

Individual Ball Control

The first obstacle in soccer is the ball. You will be presented with a variety of ball control skills each day. Proper technique will be shown starting with IvO, progressing to IvI. Feints, fakes, cuts, drags, step overs and scissors are



Team Offense

Off the ball movement, 3rd player running, and proper positioning are stressed, starting with the 2v1 format. Proper spacing, collecting & turning with the ball will be emphasized. The 2v1 model will gradually build each day to become a 5v5 model by Thursday.

Individual & Team Defense

Proper defensive stance and shape will be introduced, followed by team defense presented with a slightly different twist. Pressure, cover & support will be covered thoroughly. Your shape as an individual has an effect on your team and your opponent. Getting your opponent to dribble and pass the ball where you want them to go is huge!
