## **Scholarship Application FAQ**

### **Q. How are decisions on Scholarship awards made?**

**A.** Once the Player Application Form and any other requested documents are submitted, a committee of the MSC Board of Directors will review all applications and make recommendations to the Board of Directors. Decisions are based upon willingness to volunteer, family needs, and the amount of funds available that particular year for Scholarships. The Director of Coaching, Team Coaches and/or Team Managers can **NOT** commit scholarship funds without prior approval from the MSC Board of Directors. If a Coach or Team Manager promises you scholarship funds, there is no guarantee that they will be awarded. Final scholarship award decisions will be made solely by the MSC Board of Directors.

### **Q. Are Fusion (U11-U18 Select Teams) players eligible for Scholarship awards?**

**A.** Yes.

### **Q. How can I be assured that my application is handled confidentially?**

**A.** Completed forms will be reviewed and remain confidential to the Board of Directors. All application forms and financial documents will be placed in a secure location. All application forms and financial documents will be returned to the applicant and/or destroyed after one (1) year.

### **Q. If my family's financial situation changes during the year, can I apply for the Scholarship Program, or do I have to wait for the following year?**

**A.** You may apply at any time. However, because there are a limited number of Scholarships available, all available Scholarships may already be allocated when you apply. You will be put on a waiting list in the event a Scholarship becomes available at a later date.

### **Q. If parents are divorced or separated, do both parents need to apply or be listed on the scholarship application form?**

**A.** Yes. Information for both parents needs to be submitted on the Player Scholarship form. If a single parent family please note this on the form.

### **Q. Can scholarship awards be revoked?**

**A.** Yes. If you commit and sign with a club team and fail to pay the commitment fee, expected team fees, and/or not fulfill the volunteer commitment requirement the player scholarship may be terminated and the player become ineligible to play. This is at the sole discretion of the MSC Board of Directors.

### **Q. Are Scholarships automatically renewed annually?**

**A.** No. Applications must be submitted annually with current information in order for a player to be eligible for a Scholarship each year.
