2014 SUPER Y LEAGUE SEASON

PROGRAM DETAILS AND OVERVIEW

The Super Y program runs completely separate from a players club team. Super Y teams are built with players from many clubs, coming together for high level, competitive summer soccer. Players return to their club teams or high school teams for preseason in August. This is a great opportunity to keep skills sharp, play high level soccer, and have fun building new friendships.

What is Super Y League?

The SuperY League is a national system designed for talented youth players that enjoy playing soccer at a high competitive level and/or are destined for college, professional or international careers. The purpose is to identify players for U.S. National Team Programs, within their natural environment during competition throughout the SuperY season.

SuperY and ODP

Players are evaluated over the course of the Super Y League season. The top 18 players chosen by the divisional scouting system in each age group per geographic division will be invited to attend the ODP National Camp. These camps are attended by U.S. National Staff Coaches to identify players for U.S. National Team Programs, as well as many of the nations top college coaches. These camps are held in Florida in February and March. Mequon SuperY teams have had numerous players chosen for the National ODP camp over the past 10 seasons.

Mequon United Commitment

Our commitment to excellence in team and individual development continues into our 11th season with the SuperY League. Players who make our teams will benefit from a consistent training program and excellent coaching. Mequon United boys and girls teams have had tremendous success in the Super Y League over the years. Division Champions, National Championships, ODP National Players are all accomplishments that Mequon United teams and players have achieved. **The U15 girls team from this past summer will be traveling to Florida in December for the National Championships for the second year in a row.**

Age Groups

The Super Y League uses the same USYA age brackets (August 1 – July 31). The age brackets

you currently participate is the age bracket in which you would play during the Super Y League season. Competition for Super Y is for ages U12 through U17.

Season

The season consists of approximately 8–12 matches played over 3-4 weekends and runs from late June to early August. The teams travel on coach buses to Indiana and Michigan for their weekend games. Parent chaperones and team managers assure the safety of all players on the teams. Division point leaders (top two) will conclude the season with the Super Y League North American National Finals, held in early December in sunny, warm Florida.

Practices

Each player's club commitments come before Super Y practices. With this said, there will be team practices held approximately twice a month at either MSOE or Uihlein Soccer Park from January through March. Once the weather permits, practices will be held outside.

Tryouts!

When: November 9th, weather date is the 10th.

Times: U16/17 - 10:00-11:30 boys and girls

U14/15 - 11:45-1:15 boys and girls

U12/13 - 1:30-2:30 boys and girls

Where: Dhaliwal Soccer Park, Mequon, WI

Who: U12 - U17 players

How: Register at tryouts on the 9th starting 30 minutes prior to tryouts begin.

Cost

Try out fee - \$25

Super Y fee - \$800 and includes coaching, indoor practice fee, league fees, ref fees, and weekend transportation costs. \$50 credit if commit prior to 1/1/14.
